

**Michael L. Nichols** is the Assistant Dean for Research Administration for the Division of Research and Graduate Programs at FSU College of Medicine. He is also a Senior Research Associate in the Department of Behavioral Sciences and Social Medicine within the College of Medicine. Michael has over 20 years of experience in all aspects of sponsored research and compliance. He joined FSU from Northern Arizona University (NAU), where he was the Associate Vice President for Research and Sponsored Projects. In that role, he provided leadership and management of NAU's research administration enterprise, including overseeing the service and compliance operations of the Office of Sponsored Projects.
